## materials


- Cardstock paper (for printing)
- Paper Straws (2 per pirate, buy colors & patterns you like!)
- Pipe Cleaner (1 per pirate)
- Tape
- Scissors
- Crayons/Markers
- Googly Eyes (optional)





#### instructions


1. Print on cardstock. Color & cut out pirate heads and other items you like. 2. Tape each head to a straw.

- 3. Wrap the pipe cleaner around the straw to create arms.
- 4. Cut the second straw to the length of each arm and slip over pipe cleaner.
- 5. Leave as is or tape on any extra decorations you like—some are provided, but get creative. For example, add a googly eye!









## make your own PIRATE SHIP



### materials

- Cardstock paper (for printing)
- 12" Wood Dowel
- Paper Berry Basket
- Tape
- Double-sided tape or glue
- Hole punch
- Scissors

### instructions

- 1. Print on cardstock. Color & cut out pirate flag & sail.
- 2. For pirate flag: fold in half around the top of dowel rod. Adhere with double-sided tape or glue.
- 3. For sail: punch holes on the marked Xs. Slide onto dowel.
- 4. Place berry basket face down. Slide dowel into on of the slits in the basket. Tape on the inside to keep in place.
- 5. Decorate berry basket or leave as is.
- 6. Cut slits in the shape of an x on top of berry basket for your pirate(s)! No tape needed to keep them in place and allows the pirates to go in and out so kids can play with them.
